in Protest at the Capitol in Madison, WI**

Michael Goodwin, OPEIU International President
and other union officials will be in Madison, WI
on Friday, February 25 in support of public employees in their fight
against Governor Walker's horrific union-busting legislation!!!

We will be meeting at the First Methodist Church on the corner
of Wisconsin and Dayton Streets, between 11:30 a.m. and 12 noon
and again between 4:30 p.m. and 5 p.m. to ensure that
we all are together as a group as we protest.

The church is near the Madison Concourse hotel,
just a block or two from the Capitol building.

The International Union encourages all participants to donate a personal or
vacation day, or make an effort to get the employer to give paid released
time. In the event none of the foregoing is possible, OPEIU will reimburse
participants for lost wages for the day. For groups more than 150 miles away
from Madison, WI, OPEIU will provide for up to three representatives from
each Local Union, Guild or Directly Affiliated Group for up to two nights stay
to attend, including airfare, hotel and expenses.
